Our network

We work with a network of around 5000 hyperlocal community organisations across the UK to help us achieve our mission. We refer to them as the Online Centres Network. They are a variety of community based organisations, training providers, businesses and libraries working with people at a local level. We support them by providing resources, support, training and access to funding.

Membership of the Online Centres Network is free and open to any organisation which strives to provide people with the skills and confidence they need to access digital technology.

Our learning offer

Our flagship learning platform [Learn My Way](#) is a website of free online courses for beginners, helping people develop digital skills to make the most of their online world.

It is authored by Good Things Foundation and designed to be accessible to a wide range of audiences. It is mapped to the Essential Digital Skills Standards for entry level learners and extends to level one content. The platform offers resources for a blended learning approach.

We have a range of content designed for learners including:

- digital learning courses
- simulated practical activities
- quizzes
- printable worksheets/ handouts
- checklists
- related resource links
- a Digital Champion short course

This content is available to anyone who has registered for their free Learn My Way account.

We also have content designed for tutors and volunteers supporting learners, including:

- session plans
- learner management system
- resources links

This content is available for free to members of the Online Centres Network network.

Where to start?

We have developed a [planner tool](#) which aims to help people to get started with digital skills. It is a short self-assessment, based on the Essential Digital Skills standards. It consists of multiple choice questions. It results in a list of suggested courses on Learn My Way, personalised to suit the individual and their goals.

What else is available?

[Make It Click](#) is a collection of level one (and above) learning resources authored by trusted organisations and curated by Good Things Foundation. Amongst other things it includes: courses, guides, tools, blogs and templates.

We describe the content as 'trusted resources'. This means the resources included are all advert free, checked for accessibility and free to use.

Remote Support

Good Things Foundation has worked closely with our network partners to create a range of [remote support resources](#) to help organisations deliver digital skills support online.

This includes guides, tips, courses, documents, advice and other useful resources to use when teaching people digital skills when you can not be in the same room together.

How much does it all cost?

All of the resources created by Good Things Foundation are free to use. Some are dependent on becoming a member of the Online Centres Network. Joining and remaining part of the Online Centres Network is also free.
