Practical task - sample

Scenario

You enjoy listening to music and watching TV on your digital devices. You will check if your mobile phone has the correct software and storage space and configure some settings. Then you will do online research to find out about different music streaming providers. You will format and save your findings to a word-processing document. Lastly, you will compare the TV streaming services to advise your friend.

Task 1:

(11 marks)

Use a smartphone to do the following:

- a) find apps installed on the smartphone that can be used to listen to music
- b) choose one app, check for the latest update, and install its latest version
- c) change the smartphone sound volume setting to 50%
- d) check the amount of storage available on the smartphone
- e) set a secure password to access the smartphone
- f) enable screen lock on the smartphone

Type your findings in the document named “smartphone” and save it. Your tutor will let you know where to find it.

Practical task - sample

Scenario:

You and your friend are planning a week-long trip to Barcelona. You will research different holiday packages, including flight and hotel, organise them in a digital file and share the findings with your friend. Then you will participate in a video conference call to discuss these options. Finally, you will set up a secure online account on a holiday website.

Task 1:

(19 marks)

Use www.expedia.co.uk to find holiday options you like. The options you choose must meet the following requirements:

Flight:

- return economy flight for 2 people from your nearest international airport to Barcelona
- inbound flight must be 7 days after the outbound flight.

Hotel:

- one double room for 2 people
- stay for 6 nights



- free cancellation
- hotel 4 stars or higher
- guest rating for the hotel very good or higher.

Do not close the websites as you will need to refer back to the results you find in later tasks.

Choose 2 holiday options that meet all these requirements and create a digital file to capture all the relevant information. Make sure that you:

- use clear headings for each holiday option
- use a table to present the name of the hotel, the address and total price
- present information clearly using consistent font type and size
- include at least 1 picture of each hotel (or hotel room) and place it next to relevant option.

Create a folder named Holiday on your local drive. Save your file under the name Holiday Options in this folder.
